Did you know that Grapevine is fast becoming a nationally recognized wine region? With seven wineries, each housing its own tasting room, it's easy to see why this Texas town is an up-and-comer. This year's excursion takes guests to the Delaney Vineyards, completed in 1996, three years after the vineyard was planted. The facility contains ten lush acres of Cynthiana grapes, the best southern-bred hybrid vine to grow in the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex. After you've tasted the Delaney wines, you'll enjoy lunch at Tolbert's, a stroll down picturesque Main Street, and shopping at dozens of boutiques. Cost per person is \$54. Transportation from the Gaylord Texan Hotel is included. Note: A minimum of 40 participants is required for this tour, so sign up early!
